NIGHT WORKS – FINAL CONCRETE POUR

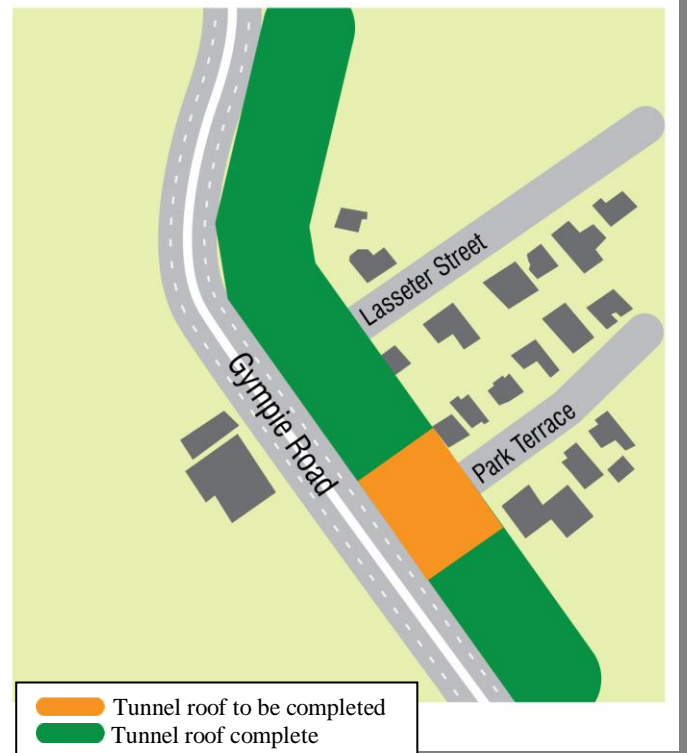
A structure encasing the Airport Link tunnel on-ramps from Stafford and Gympie Roads is currently being constructed within the Gympie Road site (Kedron Brook to Arnott Street). Upon project completion in 2012, these ramps will enable motorists to enter the tunnel at Kedron to travel to Bowen Hills or the Airport.

Further to notice 0514R3, the final concrete pour will be conducted within the Gympie Road site on 25-26 February, 2010. This pour is for the tunnel roof slab of the Airport Link on-ramps at Kedron.

As each concrete section needs to be poured in a continuous sitting, this pour will take up to 15 hours to complete. It is scheduled to take place between 10pm, Thursday 25 February and 1pm, Friday 26 February.

To ensure the noise level is kept to a minimum during these works, all reverse beepers will be replaced with a lower pitch option. Preparatory work, including finalising the installation of reinforcing steel will be undertaken from 6.30pm to the commencement of the final concrete pour.

In addition, concrete trucks will enter and exit the work-site via Gympie Road rather than local streets, when possible. The use of local roads by concrete trucks may be required during the peak morning traffic period.



What to expect

- Construction vehicle movements, including concrete trucks to and from site
- Delivery and fixing of reinforcing steel
- Lighting towers
- Concrete pumps and vibration compactors
- Construction noise.
