### KEDRON NORTH Construction Update - March

#### Stafford Road work-site

Piling for the Airport Link on-ramp at Stafford Road will be complete late March 2010. The next stage of piling will occur at the Stafford Road and Gympie Road intersection from early May 2010 weather permitting. It is anticipated to be completed the end of September 2010.

Construction activities at this site will now focus on the upcoming temporary realignment of the Gympie Road and Stafford Road intersection. Some night works will be required during April. Further notification will be provided closer to the time.

Site Establishment activities for the commencement of works on the Airport Link Operational Centre (ALOC) will also begin at the Stafford Road work-site in mid March.

#### Service Relocations

Service relocation works are ongoing in Kedron North to enable construction of the Airport Link and Northern Busway projects. These activities are scheduled to continue until approximately early May 2010, including:

- Telecommunication works continue along Stafford Road progressing towards Alma Terrace and Telstra will commence work on the southern side of the footpath along Haig Street and Lambert Street
- Installation of the new 1800 diameter stormwater pipe from the corner of Gympie Road and Swan Street progressing towards Amelia Park. Road closures are required during this work
- Electrical relocation continues along Stafford Road, Fifth Avenue, Haines Street, Park Terrace, Leckie Road, Suez Street and Swan Street, additionally new electrical infrastructure will be installed along Homebush Road, northern side within the footpath
- Water relocation from Sadlier Street along Gympie Road to Cremorne Road and at Stafford Road intersection of Clarence and Rose Lane.

#### Kedron Brook

Night works will be undertaken to assist in water treatment monitoring of the Kedron Brook. This monitoring is required to ensure all water removed from the work-site is of an acceptable standard. Monitoring will be conducted at the Haines and Perry Street sediment ponds. Work will continue for approximately three months. Machinery such as a silenced pump and lighting towers will be used throughout the monitoring process. Lighting equipment will be directed towards site, away from residential properties.

## Northern Busway – Broughton Road

Piling for the Northern Busway along Gympie Road, Broughton Road and Somerset Road continues. Once the excavation and construction of the roof structure for the cut and cover tunnel is complete, the intersection will open to traffic in early May 2010. Thereafter, Brookfield Road will be closed until approximately July 2011.

### Concrete pour

The final concrete pour for the roof of the Airport Link on-ramp north of the Kedron Brook took place on 25-26 February. It required 2800 cubic metres of concrete and was completed by 120 members of the Airport Link workforce. See pictures below.
