## Airport Link benefits

Once completed Airport Link will transform the road network in Brisbane. The primary benefits will be to provide a more reliable road network for motorists and more green and recreational spaces for the community to enjoy.

### Motorists – transforming the road network

- › Improving connections from the CBD to the northern suburbs of Brisbane
- › Increasing reliability and certainty of commercial and commuter travel time to the airport
- › Providing safer, faster and more reliable travel to the CBD, Airport and Trade Coast
- › Forecast to reduce traffic by up to 45 per cent on Lutwyche Road by 2012
- › Removing 18 sets of traffic lights between Bowen Hills and the Brisbane Airport
- › Reducing fuel costs and wear and tear on vehicles with less stop and start at traffic lights
- › Establishing smart tolling solutions – free-flow electronic tolling system
- › Reducing suburban road congestion by removing through traffic from the East West suburban roads in Clayfield, Woolloowin and Kedron.

## Public transport, pedestrians and cyclists – connecting open spaces

- › Reducing air pollution resulting from traffic congestion within the project corridor
- › Enhancing the livability of the northern suburbs with suburban road space freed up by the project available for improved public transport and pedestrian and cycling links
- › Delivering the Northern Busway as part of Airport Link
- › Incorporating new or improved cycle paths and walkways
- › Developing several hectares of new parkland by 2012.

## Communities – creating sustaining environments

- › Providing project wide initiatives which will be undertaken to link green belts and connect open spaces
- › Reducing the impact on the urban landscape with roads underground
- › Planting over one million plants, including over 5000 mature trees
- › Improving the quality of parkland amenity by building ventilation stations below ground at Bowen Hills and Toombul
- › Developing a water treatment and recycling plant to minimise the impact of operations on natural resources
- › Building the Airport Link Operations Centre (ALOC) incorporating environmentally sustainable design.
