Key Information (Note)
Community Contact Feedback -
AW – Noise from evening works in Lutwyche Rd area. Notification received advised works would be until 12am however noise was noted at 2.40am. Project advised there was a communication error. Processes put in place to prevent this occurring again.
MM – Noise coming from reverse beepers on machinery. Project advised that squawkers are being implemented as these produce less intrusive sounds. Also mentioned vehicles moving through local streets before 6am. Project advised registration numbers are required to investigate and asked community members to provide if possible.
MM – Acknowledged that community members have commented on APLNB workers being polite and courteous.
AW – Bus stop on Lutwyche road is uncovered now that buildings are demolished. Project advised that Translink are providing shelter in the coming days.
AW – What noise walls are planned between Bradshaw and Norman Streets? Project advised they are being designed and will be covered in upcoming noise wall presentation.
KA – Community Centre in Woolloowin area given contact with Kedron community representative.
MM – When should residents expect CNI resumption notifications for tunnelling and what is the process? CNI provided short summary of process and will provide details on timeframes at next meeting.
Lutwyche Rd Construction Update -
Noise mitigation for construction phase – the project is responsible for construction noise. This is differentiated from traffic noise. CNI and TJH are discussing the issue of noise mitigation with respect to exposure to traffic noise due to houses being removed. Temporary fencing will be erected between Bradshaw St and Norman Ave on the western side of Lutwyche Road and between Bradshaw St and Felix St on the eastern side. The project's designers are assessing permanent design for Lutwyche Rd. Noise modelling is currently taking place in the area.
Will the cut & cover tunnel for NB be able to carry the building loads of any future development? Yes, they are designing the tunnels to be able to build on top of them.
Construction of the diversion road for the Lutwyche busway site will get underway soon. Discussion of diversion and timeframes along Lutwyche Rd. Potential of traffic noise moving further west when traffic is switched to allow diversion.
