Windsor/Lutwyche – Clarke Park

Clarke Park will soon be reinstated to a public open space for all residents to enjoy. Upon the completion of construction in the area, the local community will have a new park fitted with bench seats, drinking fountain, bike racks and play equipment. The playground will consist of new play equipment including a dino swing with tyre, along with the existing relocated play equipment.

The park also houses the Windsor School of Arts building and will include a new car park. Pedestrian pathways will also be installed enhancing accessibility from Lutwyche Road to the newly built bus stop on Truro Street.

TREES

- *Ficus Hillii* – Hills Weeping Fig
- *Harpullia pendula* – Tulip Wood
- *Jacaranda mimosifolia* – Jacaranda
- *Tabebuia argentea* – Golden Trumpet Tree

SHRUBS

- *Hymenocallis littoralis* – Spider Lilly
- *Pyrostegia venusta* – Flame Vine
- *Strelitzia reginae* – Bird of Paradise
- *Tradescantia pallida* – Purple Heart
- *Hemerocallis cultivar* – Day Lily
- *Tulbaghia violacea* – Wild Garlic
