Gympie Road Widening Work

Activities will include:

- Asphalt removal
- Excavation
- Install drainage
- Placement of pavement gravels
- Placement of street lights
- Install kerb and gutter
- Install asphalt pavements
- Line-marking
- Vacuum excavation
- Power pole removal

What to expect:

- Services location works
- Saw cutting
- Construction vehicle movements
- Compactors
- Lane closures, under traffic control
- Removal of excavated material
- Construction noise
- Some vibration
- Back-filling
- Work on elevated platforms

Work is continuing to widen Gympie Road, between Cremorne Road and Broughton Road. In January, this work will move to the western side of Gympie Road. This will provide the necessary space for the Airport Link and Northern Busway tunnel portals and ramps. At no stage will property resumption be required for this work.

Access for local residents and businesses will be intermittently affected throughout the work; however alternative arrangements will be implemented for parking, pedestrian access and bus stops.

From 3 January 2012, the next phase of work will commence between the construction hours of 6.30am – 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. Please note that work to install barriers will occur during the week commencing 19 December 2011. This phase of work is scheduled to take approximately three months.







This phase will involve the **closure of Leckie Road at Gympie Road**. Sadlier Street will be re-opened and will be available under a left-in, left-out arrangement. A right-turn is available at Strathmore Street and there is a u-turn at Castle Street.

Some night work will be required to place barriers, conduct line marking and asphalt the road surface (6.30pm – 6.30am). Further notification will be provided prior to this occurring.
