Air Quality Monitoring Station (AQMS)

The State Government's Coordinator-General has determined air quality goals that must be achieved throughout the operation and maintenance of the Airport Link project. To demonstrate compliance with these goals two Air Quality Monitoring Stations (AQMS) must be established within 500 metre radius of each Ventilation Station Outlet.

For the Toombul Precinct, one of the AQMS is located at Aviation High School and the other will be located on private property at Lewis Street, next to the Eagle Junction Creek. The Lewis Street AQMS will be installed on a concrete hardstand approximately 6m x 6m and will be positioned on an elevated platform above the one in one hundred year flood level. A screen will be placed from the platform level to the top of the equipment.

During its operation, the AQMS would produce a low level noise similar to that of a household air-conditioner.

TJH will commence construction and installation of the AAQM during December. It is anticipated that construction will take approximately eight weeks and will involve:

- Minor excavation for construction of the concrete slab
- Steel fixing and concreting
- Use of a mobile crane
- Deliveries of construction materials and equipment via Lewis Street
- Construction activities between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday
