PROGRESS UPDATE: Decommissioning of Energex Substation

ACOUSTIC SHED

TJH has commenced the dismantling and removal of the acoustic shed. It is anticipated that this work will be complete early in the New Year however, this subject to weather during the coming weeks.

HOLIDAY PERIOD

Construction activities at the Wooloowin Worksite will cease from 6.30pm, Friday 23 December 2011 and will resume from 6.30am, Tuesday 3 January 2012.

During the week commencing Monday 19 December 2011, Energex will decommission the Energex Substation located at the corner of Kent Road and Rose Street.

This work will take place from 6.30am – 6.30pm and will require changed traffic conditions including road shoulder and footpath closures. Changed traffic conditions will be managed with traffic control.

A generator will be used from Monday 19 December 2011 to power equipment within the worksite.

Activities will include:

- Excavation of a pit to access conduits and cabling
- Cutting and removal of Energex cables

What to expect:

- Use of excavation equipment
- Use of a mobile crane
- Road shoulder and footpath closures, diversions and footpath detours
- Generator noise during and outside the Worksite's operating hours

Upcoming work:

From Monday 3 January 2012, Energex will return to the corner of Kent Road and Rose Street to remove the substation box. TJH will then break-up and remove the concrete base slab.

TJH will also commence the removal of the concrete hardstand within the acoustic noise barrier. This will require use of hydraulic hammers, concrete saw cutters, loading of materials and removal from site.
