Due to necessary lane and footpath closures this work will be completed as special circumstances work from 8pm to 5am, Monday to Saturday.

Construction and installation of audio tactiles and pram ramps <i>from Monday 9 January 2012</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sandgate Road at the Eliza Street and Noble Street intersections - Eliza Street, Noble Street and Gellibrand bus stops (inbound) - Centro Toombul (in and out bound) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saw cutting of concrete - Excavation, steel fixing and concreting
Hauling of cables <i>from Monday 9 January 2012</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - East West Arterial Road from the approximately the Widdop Street bridge to Millbrook Estate - East West Arterial Road along the trough - Sandgate Road from the Centro Toombul to East West Arterial Road intersections - Sandgate Road northbound carriageway from Eliza Street to the East West Arterial Road intersection 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Operation of a winch - Use of hand tools

* All activities will generate construction noise from vehicle movements including cranes, concrete trucks, delivery of materials, reverse alarms, use of flashing lights and temporary generators.
