## Vegetation Removal – Kedron Brook

As part of the permanent design for the Airport Link and Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) project, vegetation must be removed along Kedron Brook to allow for the construction of the viewing decks, rock beaches and riffles.

Under Brisbane City Council's *Natural Assets Local Law*, the trees will be removed on 24 January 2012. All construction design alternatives and relocation options to retain the trees have been thoroughly investigated and exhausted by the Airport Link project team.

The Airport Link project takes every care when it comes to the protection of local vegetation. Wherever possible, efforts are made to preserve or relocate trees, such as in the relocation of Hoop Pines from the Airport Roundabout to Ross Park in Toombul. More than one million plants, including 5300 trees will be planted in Brisbane as part of the project.
