Landscaping: Day and Night Work

Activities will include:

- Delivery, loading and removal of materials and equipment
- Use of a bob cat, tip truck, excavator, truck and dogs, water trucks and concrete trucks
- Installation of rocks and plantings

What to expect:

- Construction noise
- Operation of construction machinery including flashing lights and construction vehicle movements along local streets
- Footpath and short term lane closures managed with traffic control

As part of the permanent design of the Airport Link and Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) projects, landscaping is underway at Kedron.

Kedron Brook

From Friday, 13 January 2012 a pedestrian and cyclist detour will be implemented along the Kedron Brook to allow for landscaping on the southern side of the Brook. (See map overleaf) This detour will be in place until March 2012.

Landscaping work to install riffles, rock beaches and viewing platforms along the Kedron Brook has commenced as day works between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.

Riffles are sections of the brook that will be built up with rock beds and plants to alter the flow of water, aerating it for aquatic wildlife. A total of five riffles will be installed along Kedron Brook; four are located between Gympie Road and Shaw Road, one is located west of Gympie Road.

Approximately 5,000 plants will be planted for each riffle. These works have been approved by the relevant authorities.

Gympie Road

Landscaping works are also continuing in January and February along Gympie Road as both day and night works between Park Terrace and Howell Street.

Night work will commence on **Thursday, 12 January 2012** on Gympie Road between Broughton Road and Howell Street for approximately two weeks.

This work includes the installation of new footpaths and garden beds. These garden beds feature trees and shrubs in order to increase the green space across the community.

Stafford Road

Work on Stafford Road will also be required as both day and night work. Further information will be provided to nearby residents in the near future.

Day works will occur between 6.30am – 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday and night works will occur between 8pm – 5am Monday to Friday.
