## Night Works - Gympie Road

### What to expect:

- Construction vehicle movements
- Temporary lighting, including generators
- Flashing vehicle lights
- Lane closures, under traffic control
- Construction noise
- Crane movements

### What we will do to minimise impacts:

- Minimise need for machinery to reverse
- Position lighting away from residents, where possible
- Conduct noisier activities earlier in the evening, where possible.

From Thursday, 23 February night work will occur on Gympie Road between the Stafford Road/Gympie Road intersection and Homebush Road for the installation of Super T support structures for the Airport Link flyovers. This work is expected to take up to three nights, weather permitting.

This work will be conducted between 8pm - 5am due to the required lane closures on Gympie Road.

A crane will be used to lift the structures into place. These will be the final Super Ts installation for the flyovers.

### Activities will include:

- Delivery of oversized machinery
- Crane movements
- Traffic detours in place
