Construction and service relocation activities to be undertaken in the Kedron precinct during February will include:

#### Tunnelling

- Smoke duct operations continue in the tunnel on and off-ramps
- Mechanical and electrical fit-out (MEFT) of the tunnel is ongoing day and night
- Construction of egress passages and electrical rooms continues
- 24-hour shaft operations continue, supplying workforce and materials to the tunnel system

#### Kedron South

- Kedron Park Road, Gympie Road, Lutwyche Road and Norman Avenue day and night works for drainage, asphaltting, line marking, traffic signals, conduit, kerb and street light installation
- Re-building of the Kedron Park Hotel car park
- Earthworks for the tunnel off-ramps
- Concreting and support works to the tunnel off-ramps day and night
- Concreting of the ventilation passage to the Ventilation Station during day and night works
- Work on the landscaping will continue throughout February
- Gympie Road/Lutwyche Road traffic switch, which involves Lutwyche Road being realigned to the west to allow for the construction of the on-ramp

#### Kedron Central Worksite

- Construction of the on-ramp at the Kedron Central site, including drainage and service installation
- Steel-fixing, form work and concreting activities, including intermittent work at night
- Delivery and removal of oversized plant at night due to required lane closures
- Landscaping along the Kedron Brook, downstream towards the Kedron Football Club and Nelson Street and upstream of Gympie Road Bridge
- Mechanical and electrical fit-out (MEFT) of the Ventilation Station is ongoing day and night

#### Stafford Road

- Installation of gantry footings along Stafford Road west of Clarence Road
- Closure of Clarence Road to complete drainage work (approximately one week remaining)
- Stafford Road widening works continue, with the next stage scheduled to commence in March. This will include the reopening of Figgis Street, Glenfern Avenue and Bradley Avenue
- Work continues at the intersection of Stafford Road and Gympie Road to construct the Northern Busway tunnel and the final road alignment including landscaping and footpath reinstatement, with some night work required

- Excavation continues under Gympie Road, with trucks entering and exiting site from Stafford Road.
- Work continues on the Stafford Road/Gympie Road flyovers, as well as the Northern Busway Bridge. This includes the installation of drainage, pre-cast decks, lights and concrete barriers, including night work
- Construction of pavement at the flyover abutment, including barrier works
- Mechanical and electrical fit-out (MEFT) continues as day and night work within the tunnel network and ALOC

### Gympie Road

- Landscaping work will continue at Arnott and Leckie Streets and Gympie Road intersection including at night
- Demolition of the concrete slab between the Stafford/Gympie Road intersection and Brookfield Road below the Gympie Road flyover
- Gympie Road widening works between Cremorne Road and Broughton Road are ongoing. Works are scheduled to move to the centre of Gympie Road in March. Leckie Road will re-open at Gympie Road at this time
- Installation of pre-cast panels and backfilling for the retaining wall on Gympie Road between Leckie Road and Sadlier Street along with drainage, kerbing and footpaths
- Bus stop construction northbound near Howell Street
- Kedron Brook remains diverted until excavation is completed
- Road reconstruction activities north of Homebush Road continue
- Landscaping work on Gympie Road between Brookfield and Homebush Roads during the day and night
- Mechanical and electrical fit-out (MEFT) continues as day and night work within the Northern Busway tunnel network
- Delivery and removal of oversized plant at night due to required lane closures
- Pavement works on Somerset Road
- Installation of the Super T structures as part of the Gympie Road flyover

### Kedron Busway Station

- Commissioning of the lifts
- Installation of furniture and signage at the platforms
- Perry Street extension work continues, including service installation and kerbing
- Perry Street landscaping and noise wall construction including footpaths
- Landscaping at the Norman Avenue, Perry Street and Lutwyche Road intersection

### Service Relocations

Service relocation works will be ongoing during day and night works in Kedron:

- Communication service installation on Gympie Road, Lutwyche Road, Kedron Park Road, Somerset Road, Nieppe Street and Norman Avenue
- Gas contractors are continuing works within the footpaths of Gympie Road
- Electrical service works along Gympie Road, Kedron Park Road, Stafford Road, Leckie Road and Lutwyche Road
- Water service works along Gympie Road, Stafford Road, Swan Street and Rose Lane
- Intermittent night and day works along Gympie Road, Lutwyche Road, Norman Avenue, Clarence Street and Kedron Park Road for drainage

### Surveying

- Survey mark removal and surface surveying will be undertaken at various locations across the precinct. Night work may be required
