### TUNNELLING

**Truro Street Worksite** - 24-hour work within the Airport Link tunnels continues, with smoke duct installation, mechanical and electrical fit-out and rectification work. The backfill of the access decline will commence in early February and the removal of site offices will occur in March. The Northern Busway Tunnel (Truro Street to Lutwyche Busway Station) is currently going through the commissioning stage, with power to the tunnel now active.

**Bradshaw Street to Norman Avenue** – The mechanical and electrical fit-out of the cut-and-cover tunnel between Bradshaw Street and Norman Avenue is ongoing. Commissioning of this tunnel has also commenced.

### NORTHERN BUSWAY

**Quarry Park** - Work on the 'bus jump' within Quarry Park is ongoing, as part of the final design for bus access into the dedicated Truro Street bus lane. Work on the final asphalt overlay, line marking and installation of traffic signals continues, during day and night works.

**Truro Street** - Construction of the Northern Busway's dedicated bus lanes, bus stops and tunnel entrance continues within Clarke Park, including kerbing and barriers. Installation of bus shelters will occur in the coming months. Works will also continue on the final configuration of Truro Street, including kerbing installation at the Fosbery Street end.

**Lutwyche Busway Station** – Landscaping within the busway station is currently being finalised, along with the work on the platforms and towers

**Perry Street** - Work continues on the Perry Street extension including asphaltting and kerbing. Work also continues on the noise wall, footpaths and landscaping. Day works will be required in Colton Avenue and Perry Street for road surface work.

**Surface Work** - Work continues on Lutwyche Road, from High Street to Albion Road, during day and night time hours. Activities include kerbing work and traffic signal upgrades.

Night and day work will be ongoing on Lutwyche Road between Chalk Street and Felix Street and on Bradshaw Street for new sewer crossings and road works. Profiling at the Lutwyche Road and Bradshaw Street intersection will also occur at night.

**Footpath and Landscaping** - Footpath reinstatement will continue across the precinct both day and night. Areas of reinstatement include: Lutwyche Road, Truro Street and Roblane Street.

Landscaping will also be implemented across the precinct including at Clarke Park, Perry Street, Truro Street, Lutwyche Road and Norman Avenue.

**Service Installation** - The essential service relocation program in Lutwyche/Windsor is nearing completion. Activities in February will include:

**Electrical**

- Day/night work on Lutwyche Road between Fuller Street and Felix Street
- Day/night work to haul cables on Chalk Street, Lutwyche Road, Bradshaw Street and Lamington Avenue

**Water/Drainage**

- Day/Night work at Quarry Park
- Day/Night work on Roblane Street
- Day work on Bonython Street
- Day/Night work on Norman Avenue and on Lutwyche Road from Norman Avenue to Chalk Street

Day work will occur from 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday and night work will be undertaken from 8pm to 5am, Sunday to Saturday. This timing is dependent on road closure permits.

Night work must be undertaken for various reasons, including minimising traffic disruption on Lutwyche Road. More details regarding all night work activities will be provided closer to commencement.
