GROUNDWATER MONITORING

- Ongoing

Thiess John Holland, contracted by BrisConnections to design and construct the Airport Link, Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) and Airport Roundabout Upgrade, is required to regularly monitor underground water levels and quality along the route of the projects.

What does this mean?

Ongoing groundwater monitoring has already been occurring along the projects' alignment and will continue approximately every two weeks for the next four months. The sites used for the previous investigations will again be used to monitor water levels and quality. Workers will take between 2-3 hours to complete their studies at each site, with the work conducted on weekdays between 7am and 5pm, unless otherwise notified. You should not experience any impacts as a result of this work, other than some noise associated with an air compressor. Traffic controllers will be used to maintain traffic flow if the work affects normal vehicle movements.

Further investigations may be necessary in the future and you will be notified in advance.
