### BOWEN HILLS Lutwyche Road Traffic Changes

**From the evening of Saturday 1 May, changes will occur to the operation of the Federation Street/Lutwyche Road intersection together with changes to traffic conditions on Lutwyche Road between Northey Street and Newmarket Road.**

**Night works will be required on Friday 30 April and Saturday 1 May to implement these changes.**

These traffic changes are required to facilitate the construction of the Airport Link Lutwyche Road off-ramp and ensure safe access for residents, cyclists and motorists throughout these works.

#### **Lutwyche Road and Inner City Bypass Changes**

Lutwyche Road northbound will be reduced to three lanes between Northey Street and Newmarket Road. This change will also require the closure of the right-hand lane on the Inner City Bypass off-ramp.

*This traffic change will reduce the construction impacts on Lutwyche Road from 10 months to 6 months. The construction methods have been chosen to minimise the duration and impacts of the works. Delays may be experienced during peak periods.*

#### **Lutwyche Road/Federation Street Intersection Access Changes**

Concrete barriers will be placed along Lutwyche Road from Northey Street to Newmarket Road. This will require the decommissioning of the traffic signals at the intersection of Federation Street and Lutwyche Road. The following access changes will therefore be implemented:

- No right-turn from Federation Street to Lutwyche Road northbound. A detour will be in place for northbound traffic. (Please refer to the map for further details)
- Pedestrians and cyclists wishing to cross Lutwyche Road will do so via the Newmarket Road intersection. (Please refer to the map for further details)

The left-turn to Lutwyche Road southbound and from Lutwyche Road into Federation Street will be maintained.

**This change will be in place for approximately 7 months at which time the new Gallway Street intersection will open and the right turn to Lutwyche Road northbound will be reinstated.**

Thiess John Holland realises these changes will cause inconvenience for Federation, Morris, Gallway and Bryden Street residents and apologises for any disruption during the construction of these vital infrastructure projects.

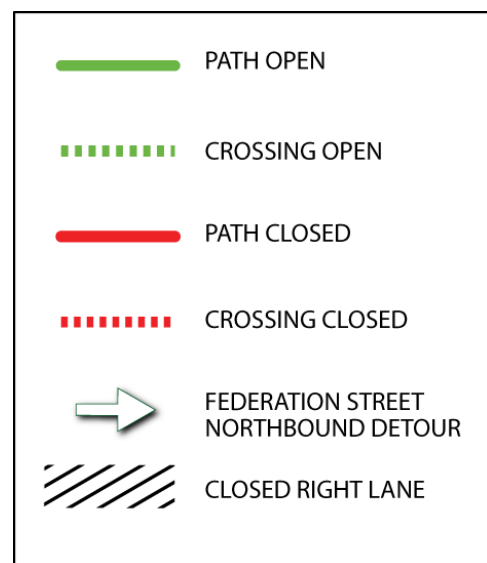
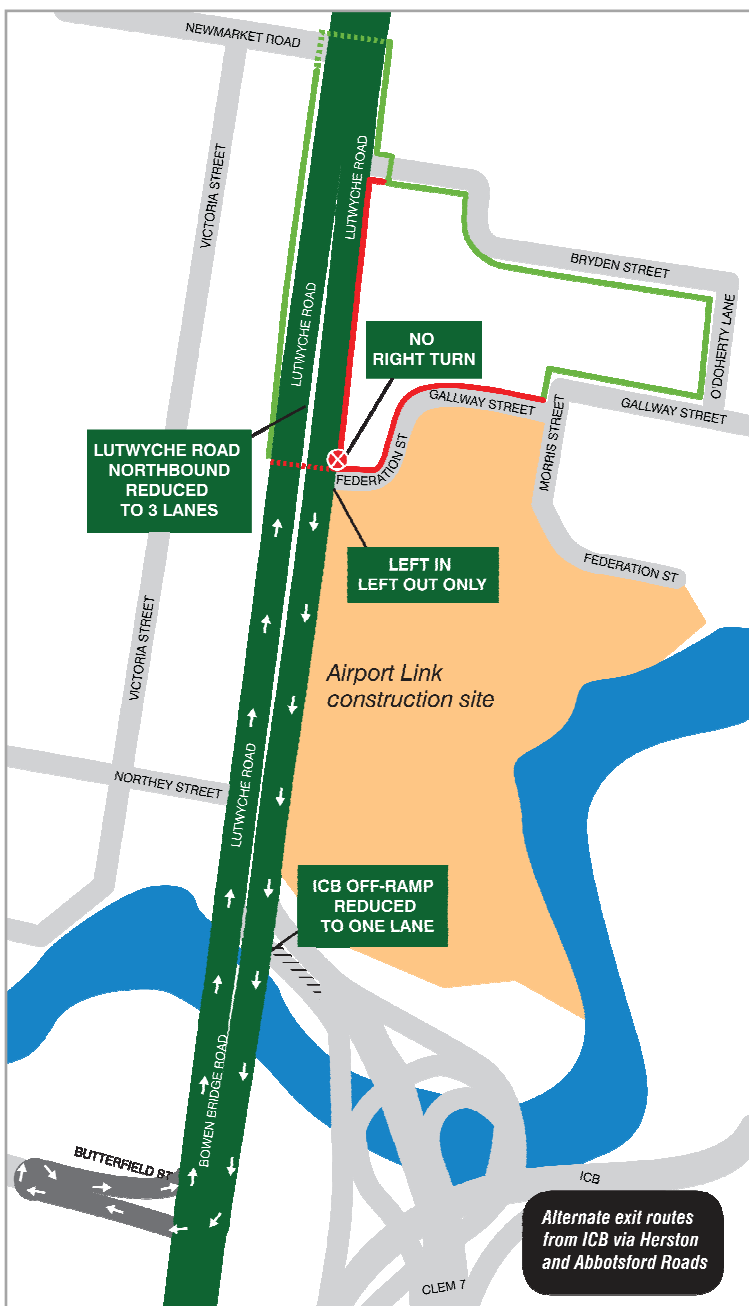
