Traffic Management

Thiess John Holland is working with the Brisbane Metropolitan Transport Management Centre, the Department of Main Roads, Translink and Brisbane City Council to ensure traffic management is co-ordinated throughout construction of these critical projects.

Thiess John Holland will conduct regular traffic analysis to ensure traffic flow is maintained during construction of the Airport Link, Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) and Airport Roundabout Upgrade Projects.

To facilitate construction of the projects, changes to the existing traffic conditions will be necessary to ensure traffic flow is maintained.

The types of changes required throughout construction may include diversions, detours, road and pathway realignments, pavement markings and temporary lane, road and pathway closures.

Temporary changes will be clearly marked and managed by controlling the traffic conditions.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times. Work in close proximity to local businesses will be carried out in consultation with the business to ensure normal business operations are maintained.

In some cases, public transport services may be adjusted. For example, bus stops may be relocated or removed. Public transport users will be advised prior to any changes.

All changed traffic conditions will be implemented in accordance with the *Austroad* standards and the relevant road authorities' permission.

You can expect to see the following types of signage on the road and pathway network when changed traffic conditions are in place:

- Reduce speed
- Flagman operations (stop / slow)
- Electronic message boards
- Roadwork ahead
- Detour and directional

You will be kept informed of traffic changes in your local area via the Community Update newsletter and community notice's which may include a map to detail alternate routes throughout the construction period.
