## Woolloowin Worksite - Working with the Community

The land used for the Woolloowin worksite will become an asset for the Woolloowin community at the end of the project in mid 2012.

### Community Liaison Groups

As part of our commitment to working with the community, a Community Liaison Group (CLG) will be established prior to excavation of the shaft for the Woolloowin precinct.

CLGs meet regularly and represent the community to identify and communicate issues, ideas and opportunities to the project team and the State. Local businesses, residents and community organisations are members of the CLGs and ensure a broad array of community concerns and interests are addressed. TJH will be advertising for applications shortly.

### Future land use and community development

BrisConnections and Thiess John Holland will fund an Urban Mitigation and Community Development Project which will include an independently facilitated consultation process with the local community. This process will assist to identify opportunities for community assets. Options for consideration will include bicycle and pedestrian facilities, amenity improvements to the local area or urban design enhancements.

### School Crossing

Subject to road authority approval, Thiess John Holland will build a school crossing on Park Road in front of Kedron State High School.

Thiess John Holland will manage this crossing with a Traffic Controller, when the site's spoil haulage commences, during school drop off and pick up hours.

### Keeping you informed

Thiess John Holland will advise residents of new activities that may have an impact 48 hours before the activity starting via community notices, email and letterbox distribution of community notices, door knocks and newsletters. Information days will also be held on a six monthly basis.

Residents and businesses will be notified seven days prior to the beginning of the 24 hour tunnelling operation.
