### **Weekend closure of CLEM7 for construction of Airport Link project**

Motorists travelling to and from the northern and southern suburbs via the Inner City Bypass and CLEM7 tunnel should allow additional travel time this long weekend as work continues for the Airport Link and Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) projects.

The following closures are required to facilitate the opening of a new CLEM7 bridge connection, which links traffic from Lutwyche Road north and southbound to the CLEM7.

- From 8pm Sunday 1 May both the north and southbound CLEM7 tunnels will close.
- The northbound CLEM7 tunnel and the CLEM7 southbound on-ramps from the ICB will reopen at 8am on Monday 2 May.
- Access to CLEM7 southbound will be restored at 4pm on Monday 2 May via the new bridge from Lutwyche Road.

This bridge is the third of 12 traffic bridges constructed by Thiess John Holland to open to traffic for the Airport Link and Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) projects.

Traffic management and signage will be in place to assist motorists, however drivers are advised to avoid the area if possible and to add additional travel time to their journey.

The Airport Link and Northern Busway (Windsor to Kedron) projects are being designed and constructed by Thiess John Holland, along with the Airport Roundabout Upgrade, is part of a massive \$4.8 billion infrastructure investment on Brisbane's Northside.
