Airport Link response to Queensland Ombudsman Report

We are pleased to see that the Ombudsman has rejected the allegations made by Mr Nally in June 2010 that construction work being conducted by TJH on the Airport Link project was unlawful.

The basis of Mr Nally's initial complaint to the Ombudsman was that TJH was operating unlawfully and outside the work hours set by the conditions of approval for the project. The outcome of the Ombudsman's investigation clearly states that the conditions allow surface work to be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am Monday to Saturday and on Sundays and public holidays.

We are and will continue to conduct our operations in accordance with the conditions that have been established for the project and will continue to work co-operatively with the compliance agencies as we complete construction of the project.
