<b>Key Information (Note)</b>
Indent of Bus Stop at Grafton Street – Provide update in news letter.to raise community awareness.
Traffic team to return to CLG after the TMP has been approved and provide an update.
Wooloowin Community Centre made contact with CLG member. Being actioned with APLNB community team.
Noted that family of Arthur Collwill have been assured that the bus stop at Colwill Place is remaining.
WSOA completion date is still end of April. Heritage Week is end of May. Noted that the council will be responsible for WSoA once it is completed and contact details for Council will be passed onto Windsor Historical Society.
Update provided on Truro Street site works, including piling, acoustic shed, hoarding, roadheader.
Update on Lutwyche Lamington Ave site. Demolition will be complete in the middle of March aside from few last properties. Construction of diversion roads will commence.
Q - Relocation of bus stops in Bradshaw street? A – No intention of relocations at this stage in the particular area
Q- Will any footpaths be closed along Lutwyche Road? A – Yes. The western footpath from Bradshaw Street to Norman Avenue will be closed during construction. There may be other temporary closures. These will be notified in advance.
Q – Where will the rubble be taken that is removed from site? A – The rubble will be removed by trucks to designated spoil sites. These are not final yet. Some spoil from the Truro Street tunnelling site will be used for fill at the Lutwyche Busway Station site.
