3.0	<p>Air Quality presentation</p> <p>Questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will height of ventilation outlet be increased during the design review? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The ventilation outlet height is not expected to be changed, however we need to confirm that the height complies with the Coordinator General's conditions. ○ CLG members will be informed should the height need to be changed and will be involved in the process. • If the height of the outlet is changed during the design review, this information needs to be passed on to the community. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ This information will be communicated to the community. • Where will the permanent air quality monitoring stations be located and when will they be installed? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The permanent air quality monitoring stations will be in a similar location to the temporary monitoring stations to ensure consistency of data. ○ We are currently investigating possible locations for these monitoring stations. They require significant resources to operate including access to power. ○ The potential locations for air quality monitoring will be brought to the CLG for comment. • Enquired when will the air quality monitoring stations commence operation? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Mid 2009 – need to be operational at least 12 months prior to tunnel operation. • CLG member concerned that the air quality monitoring stations won't be operational for another 6 months.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The project will do its utmost to follow the Australian standards with regard to baseline air quality monitoring. ● Enquired whether the ventilation outlet will be filtered? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All ventilation outlets for the Airport Link project will be capable of retrofitting filtration devices at a later date, if the filtration is deemed necessary and proven to be effective.
4.0	<p>Monthly construction update – to mid Nov:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Commencement of activity in Centro Toombul carpark – office construction ● Commencement of work on footpath on northern side of Schulz Canal - current footpath will remain in place until new footpath built ● Erection of fencing in Kalinga Park ● Ground improvement trial - soil mixing ● Construction of access road to commence - under Sandgate Road bridge ● Commencement of demolition
5.0	<p>General business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cycle and pedestrian access – to be discussed in more detail next week ● Hill behind Kalinga Street residents – will it remain? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Endeavour to leave hill as is and place equipment around it. ● Noise wall behind Kalinga Street residents <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Will follow existing lie of the land. ● Removal of trees in Kalinga Park on western side of railway line <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Trees in Digger's drive remain – except for one. ○ Trees behind Kalinga Street to be removed. ○ Trees only to removed within construction area. ● Is there a concrete batching plant? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No. There will be a Bentonite plant which has a wet, muddy consistency.
